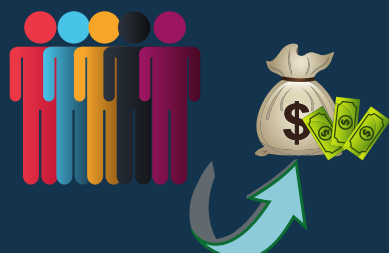


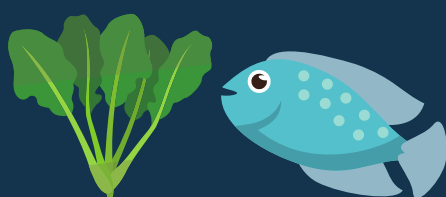

Access to quality medical care and recreational programs



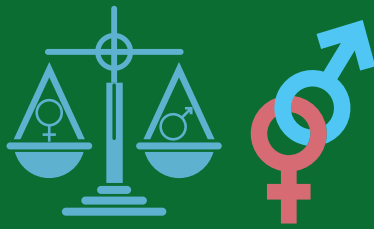
4. QUALITY EDUCATION

Empowering & enabling women & girls to contribute socially & financially to society



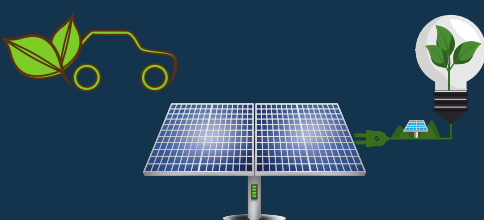
6. CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION

The application of Spire's technology in it's eco-satellite, near carbon neutral cities



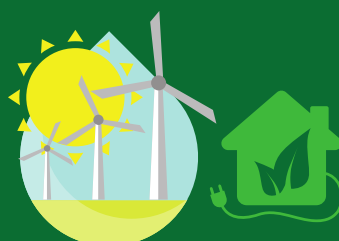
10. REDUCED INEQUALITIES

Proactive development of sustainable technologies & processes to reduce & eliminate Greenhouse Gas Emissions

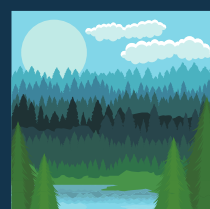
